I John Painter
 a mariner belonging unto her Majesty's Shipp Sunderland being
 of sound and perfect mind and memory doe (for avoiding some
 controversies after my death) make and ordain this my last will
 and Testament in manner following first I recommend my
 soule to God that gave it and body I commend to the Earth or
 sea as it shall please God to order And as for all my worldly Estate
 I doe give and bequeath as followeth viz: All my pay and wages
 which is or may become due unto me for my service on board her
 Majesty's Shipp Sunderland or any other Shipp or vessel and all
 debts and other wages due and due of money which is
 or may become due to me at the time of my decease I doe give
 and bequeath the same unto my loving Sister Elizabeth Painter
 of the parish of Saint Claves Hart Street And I doe nominate
 the said Elizabeth Painter sole Executor of this my said will and
 Testament hereby making all former and other wills by me
 heretofore made And I doe ordain those presents to be for and
 as my only last will and Testament In witness whereof to this
 my said will I have hereunto sett my hand and seal this
 Eighteenth day of October Anno Domini 1706. in the 5th
 year of the Reigne of her Majesty Queen Anne over England
 &c. John Painter. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence
 of us Richard Whitaker, Thomas Kinge, John Thornbor.
